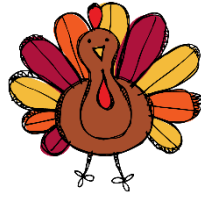

Walk for Wishes

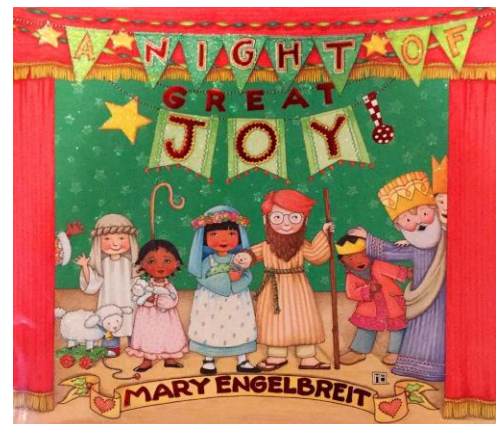

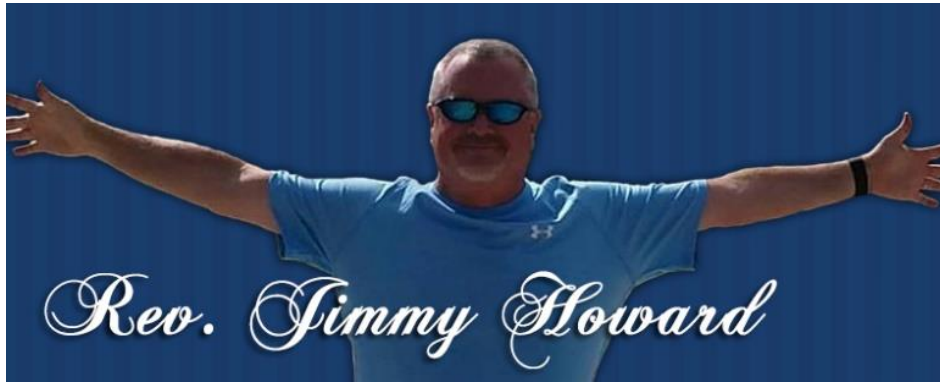


A Night of Great Joy!
